GRADE 1 SUPPLY LIST - Sept. 2023

Dear Parents/Guardian:

Please send all of the following supplies to school on the first day. I will keep the supplies in a separate envelope for your child to use as needed. Any supplies your child does not use will be sent home at the end of the year. **Mark his/her name or initials on everything please, including sharpened pencils.** These supplies may last the whole year, but your child may require extra pencils and glue after Christmas.

- 10 Erasers (*preferably the white art erasers*)
- 24 Pencils (*sharpened and with student's name on*)
- 1 Pkg of 24 Pencil Crayons
- 3 Duotangs
- 1 Pencil Case or Pencil Box
- 8 Glue Sticks if small and 4 if they are the big ones
- 2 Exercise Books – wide ruled (*not interlined*)
- 1 Small Exercise Book – ½ lined ½ plain (*not interlined*)
- 1 Pair of Scissors (*should be a fairly good quality and no plastic scissors*)
- 1 Paint T-Shirt (*with name on it*) (*T-Shirts without buttons work best.*)
- Change of Clothing for Emergencies and Muddy Days (*old pants, shirt, socks, and underwear*) (*to be left at school*)
- Backpack Large Enough to Carry Homework and Library Books. **No** Readers or Library Books will be sent home without a bag.
- Indoor Running Shoes – **NO HEELYS Please!!** (*shoes without wheels*)
- Small Plastic Water Bottle if your child chooses to have one at his/her desk. Please be sure it has a closable lid and not just a screw on lid. (*please wash nightly*)
- 2 Boxes of Kleenex (*to be used as a class*)
- 1 Set of Headphones for Computers (*labeled with student's name please*)
Recommend over the ear kind and not the ear buds

Please mark his/her name or initials on everything including sharpened pencils, as well as all coats, mitts, hats, shoes & boots.

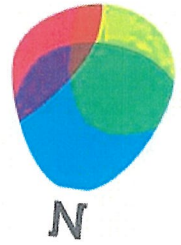

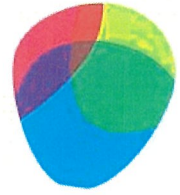
